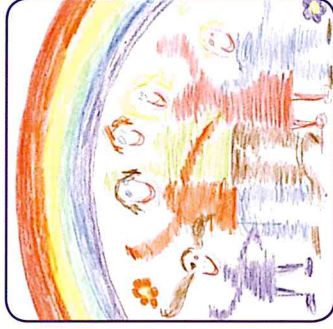

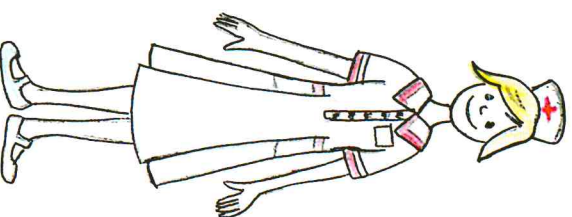

The nurses in our team can

- **give you an opportunity to talk about your health** which will be confidential, unless you tell us something that harms you or someone else
- **undertake your health assessment** and discuss any worries you may have
- **discuss any concerns you have** around weight, diet, sexual health, drugs, smoking, anxiety or stress
- **provide** condoms, pregnancy tests and chlamydia tests
- **give advice about** immunisations and let you know what you have had so far. The nurses can also give injections such as Diphtheria, Tetanus and Polio
- **listen and try to help!**
